Campout facts/Rules

General Rules

Quiet hours are from 10 PM – 6 AM
Discharging firearms, BB guns, slingshots in campground is prohibited
ATV's prohibited in campgrounds
Video cameras NOT allowed
Pets NOT allowed without special permission (contact president or Road Captain)
There are NO shelters at Miller River, Please provide your own shelter (tent, RV, Etc)
NO Entry to campground prior to 2:00 PM May 28.
NO public use of illegal substances
Keep your campground clean
Motor homes greater than 30 feet long need to be pre-approved
Applications must be received by May 21 to receive a confirmation other than via E-mail

Campfire/Wood

Campfires are permitted in designated rings and barbeques only!

I wanna build my own campfire; can I just use some of the wood from the main campsite? **NO.**

We purchase and have trucked in enough firewood to keep the main campsite going all weekend.

We do not provide FREE firewood for individual campsite fires. You are welcome to bring in firewood for your personal use.

HOWEVER, if you PRE-PAY, we will order extra wood for you with our order. You can pick up this wood, when you check in. Indicate *order wood* under other on application and add \$15.00 to the amount sent with the application

Cigarettes

Please do not put cigarettes out on the ground. Use the butt-cans provided around the campground. This will help reduce the fire hazard and make it easier to clean up when we close down on Monday.

Trash

Littering will not be tolerated. Please pickup after yourself. Use the trash cans provided.

Plumbing Facilities

There are wells in the campground that can provide water for washing etc. We encourage you to drink the water we provide. **Please don't drink the river water.**

The forest service provides clean out-houses for our use. If you notice something missing or a problem please let us know.

There is no running water, flush toilets or RV waste dumps on site so plan accordingly.

Thing to consider

- Don't forget personal items (sleeping bag, toiletries, warm clothes, coats, flashlight, etc)
- Air mattress – the ground is lumpy
- Tarp (something dry) – it some times rains on this weekend
- Extra clothes – same reason as above
